Novice Acting 9-10am

**Grades K-1
\$75**

Jump into the magical world of theater! Novice Acting will focus on the very basics of theater through fun lessons, games, and activities. Curriculum is centered around helping students in kindergarten and first grade find their voices and use them to tell a story.

Apprentice Acting 10:30-11:30am

**Grades 2-3
\$75**

Students in second and third grades will have the opportunity to build on their acting skills. Lessons and activities will focus on blocking, reading with feeling, and projection.

Journeyman Acting 11am-12pm

**Grades 4-6
\$75**

Fourth, fifth, and sixth grade students will work to master memorization skills, create characters, and make stage-appropriate choices.

Virtuoso Acting 11am-12pm

**Grades 7-12
\$75**

Both beginner and returning students in seventh through twelfth grades will discover exciting ways to bring characters to life! Students will be able to create characters and make blocking and scene choices with the supervision of the instructor.

Intro to Musical Theater 10-11am

**Grades 4-8
\$75**

Dive into the world of musical theater in this class! Students will add to their basic dance, acting, and vocal skills while exploring more advanced techniques. This is the perfect step from the classroom to the stage!

Performance Lab 12-1:30pm

**Grades 6-12
\$100**

This is our elite performance-based class offered at MCT. Throughout the semester, students will prepare a fully produced musical that is performed on the Beardsley Stage. There will be one production performed after our fall session and one performed after our spring session with additional tech rehearsals the week of performances (see dates below). Students need to have completed Virtuoso Acting, Intro to Musical Theater, or have prior stage experience to be registered in this class.

- All classes take place in the Hilt Building.

Please note that your student is not officially registered until payment has been processed by Muskegon Civic Theatre. Your child's spot may be filled by another student if your payment is not submitted and there is a waitlist for the class.
